

Get your engines running! The home wine competition season is beginning. Bear in mind that if you wish to enter the Sacramento Home Winemakers Rex Johnston Winemaker of the Year competition for 2019, you must have entered at least two separate and distinct wines (as far as variety and harvest year) in both the 2019 Sacramento Home Wine Jubilee Competition and the California State Fair, and one other recognized 2019 home wine competition. The deadline for entering WOY is November 30, 2019. State-wide, home wine competition organizers are still shaking the New Year's confetti out of their hair, so look to this monthly column as more competitions are announced.

The Hal Ellis Memorial Service Award has been presented by SHW for many years. This award recognizes volunteerism and is presented for "Service Above and Beyond the Crush"

ing wine evaluation, he was the go-to source for help and information, and he made sure that each year he and his group-"The Donner Boys" would donate, as a fund raising auction item, an amazing home-cooked gourmet dinner for six with all the food and wine that could be consumed. Each year this was one of the most desired and sought after auction items and it helped raise many thousands of dollars over the years for SHW.

This is only a partial example of Henry Wilkinson's legacy in the spirit of volunteerism; he actually made many, many more contributions to SHW. Henry was loved by everyone and certainly epitomized "Service Above and Beyond the Crush".
